## **Best Practices: Back-up**

### There's a saying: "Only back up the information you don't want to lose."

We here at Datacon are sticklers about backing up data. We have seen the consequences of not backing up. If a catastrophe happens, you want to be ready. We have clients who have had fires, burglaries and disk failures. If you have a good backup, it is possible for you to be up and running the same day. Be sure to back up your Datacon system and if you are storing images on a PC server, you need to have a backup of that as well.

You need to do this every day. You need to have a backup tape, hard drive or DVD for every day of the week that you work. Take the most current back-up off-premises, so if there is a fire, you'll have your data. You should carry your previous day's backup with you home and bring it back the next day. That way you will always have it in case you need to restore files.

### Do you know where your data is? Do you know if your data is being backed up?

You should know your data and how it's being backed up. Never just assume your data is safe. All forms of backups should be verified on a daily basis.

For example, if you are on an Alpha Micro of any kind, your tape backup does NOT backup any images, PC Word documents, etc. If you have a separate image server than your Datacon server, it requires a backup of it's own. Our new Mac Pro server will backup your Datacon as well as any images, documents, etc., in one place.

Are your employees saving those important Word documents on their local machines? A good practice is to have all important documents stored on a server that is getting backed up.

### Are You Protected?

Most of you know that you should have antivirus protection if you are on-line, but did you know that if you have DSL or Cable internet on one or more of your computers, all of your networked pcs are on-line? Even if a machine cannot browse the internet, it should have antivirus protection to help protect against network aware infections. An infection can get on another machine and get to the unprotected machine using the same avenue that machine uses to connect to Datacon and your imaging software.

In addition, if you use a machine to actively surf the internet, say for web claims, email, etc., it should have antispyware protection as well as antivirus protection. Anti-spyware protection will protect you against spyware and adware. This software can be part of your antivirus protection but MUST be something running at all times or you will have to run manual scans of the systems.
