This update has been "Under Construction" for the better part of a year and we hope you will agree that it is worth the wait. We are always wanting to improve and always listening to what our clients are saying. While our experienced users generally consider the software to be easy to use, some who are new to Datacon say it is not intuitive. We have been around for a long time and what was intuitive fifteen years ago may not be today so we have done a major overhaul of the look and feel of our screens. In most cases we have managed to do this without changing too much for those of you who are accustomed to using certain keystrokes but for the mouse users out there, we have added lots of new controls that make it obvious what can be changed or selected.

We have been talking about Datacon Mobile for a while and we are now ready to begin rolling out this exciting new feature with the 3.6D software release. Datacon Mobile

allows you to use your iPhone, iPad, or other mobile device equipped with a compatible web browser to access information from anywhere you happen to be. You can review or confirm upcoming appointments, follow up with patients after treatment, and access financial information. Datacon Mobile is a free update for those using a Mac server. Installation, training and batteries not included.

There are a number of other new features in this software release. These include a separate tab for prescriptions in the patient chart, improvements to ortho billing, and the option to separate accounts with credits into their own aging category. We also have new reports, a new privilege to control who can access your system remotely, and thousands of small changes to improve usability and flexibility and to respond to your requests.

For the majority of you who have updated to Mac servers the big news is Datacon Mobile but the update also includes the option to print to PDF, automatic archiving of PDF copies of Deposit Slips and Control Sheets, and improvements to the backup system including the ability to temporarily recover a backup to review it's content and retrieve deleted information or numbers that have since changed.

We have quite a few additional enhancements we expect to release very soon and that brings us to the last of the major new features we are including in this release. Going forward, those of you who have Internet connectivity will be able to check for updates online whenever you like and install them at your convenience. This will allow us to deliver improvements and respond to requests much more quickly and efficiently than we have in the past. We hope you are as excited about this as we are.

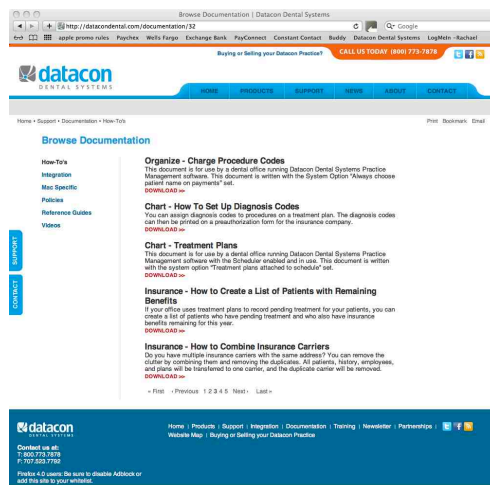

Procedure Categories

Procedure categories can be customized in Datacon in order to facilitate ease of procedure code tracking and reporting. Once a procedure category is created and procedure codes have been specified for it, the category can be tracked as a whole unit. For example, you might want to group all of your restoration procedures into one category so that you can run a transaction analysis report on restoration codes as a group. When running the transaction analysis report, you need only select the procedure category rather than each individual code.
